Purpose: To fulfill the requirement of motion 41P which changed the structure of the Florida Regional Service Conference. The completed guidelines will integrate the Admin Team, Fellowship Development, the Human Resource Panel and the member areas (RCMs, subcommittees and members @ large and provide a simplified consistent guide for any NA member who would like to know how the Florida Region conduct business.

Financial Impact: The cost of reprinting the final copies for distribution will be about \$250.00. This cost is well within the budgeted amount in the 2009 Fellowship Development Budget.

Recommendations: To approve the amended Guide to Florida Regional Service and make available for distribution. A copy of the document has been posted to the Heartland website, as well as posted as a file on the Yahoo group. This proposal will be voted on at our next Area Service Committee meeting, 3/14/10.

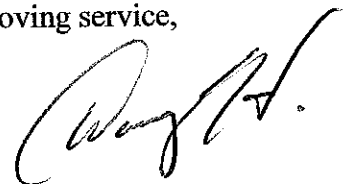
Bowling night was scheduled for Feb. 13th at 9pm Orange Bowl Lanes in Lakeland, flyers distributed at area.

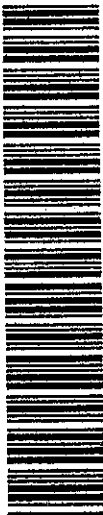
