RCM 1 Report to HASC, October 2022

I am an addict; my name is Ron. I am Heartland Area's Regional Committee Member (RCM). For those of you who don't know what I do, here are the highlights:

- Just as you GSRs are representatives for your respective group at HASC, I am a representative for the Heartland Area at the Regional Service Committee (RSC). I am a liaison between our Area and the Florida Region (and the rest NA, inclusive of NA World Services).
- RSC weekend is held every other month, typically in Orlando or Tampa. It is a weekend-long service event where all the RCMs from all over the Florida Region get together, as well as the Regional Delegate and Alternate Delegate (RD and AD,

respectively), Regional Coordinators (PR, H&I, IT, etc.), Human Resources (HRP), FRCNA, RSO and others. This is the time when, much like here at HASC, we all get together to collaborate, carry NA's message, and help each other. We discuss any issues that an area may be having and provide each other with experience, strength, and hope – and potentially create workgroups to help find solutions for more complex issues. We hear the reports from all the different Coordinators, boards, and the news from NA World from the RD/AD team. We vote our area's conscience on proposals (motions) from the Region and World.

- Every RSC weekend, the RCM Team provide a report of all the things going on in our Area (issues, events, votes, etc.).
- Then, every month, here at HASC, we pass along the information that was covered at RSC, so (hopefully), GSRs can deliver information back to home groups.
- Any member is welcomed to join in on an RSC weekend! No service commitments or clean time required. All we ask is that if you're staying in a room, you provide a report to HASC about what you saw, learned, or participated in while you were there.

Treasurer Report

On July 1, 2022, the opening bank balance was \$41,857.08. After deposits of \$31,430.94 and expenses of \$8,160.24 on August 31, 2022, the ending book balance was \$65,127.78. After deducting \$10,000.00 withheld for the next RSC, the Prudent Reserve of \$11,000.00, a Women in Service Donation of \$75.00, the GSR Assembly Reserve of \$3,000.00, and the Florida Service Symposium Reserve of \$18,000.00 the available balance was \$23,052.78

As of RSC held on September 18, 2022, we received \$4,046.66 in income and had \$4,911.35 in expenses. The RSC Treasurer allocated the monthly reserve of \$500.00 for the GSR Assembly & \$1,000.00 the Florida Service Symposium. Therefore, after RSC business the available balance was \$20,688.09.

In our second session we deviated from our RSC FD typical afternoon session at the request of the AD/RD team and a US Zone Ad-Hoc committee to receive and discuss again information on the idea of a Collaboration of US Zones. Two members of that committee (Craig N.C. and Dawn, Montana)

Heartland area has already tabled this to groups and came back with an area conscious two months ago. We did not support this. Many felt lobbied with a return of this issue to be presented twice. The second presentation appeared more to influence rather than inform the body. Now after we have voted there is a request for a survey. Some have asked how this self-made task team can mandate a survey since we have made it clear we want no part of this US collaboration. We have asked the RD/AD Team to please not use

this survey as pro or con. Why survey if our groups have voted on this issue. I wish a straw poll now to determine the need to approach this poll out to groups after we have already voted on this issue.

After that discussion the RD/AD team opened discussions regarding the WSC motion coming forward at our upcoming WSC to try a Three Year WSC cycle.

H & I Resource Coordinator Report
