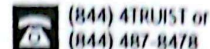
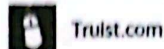

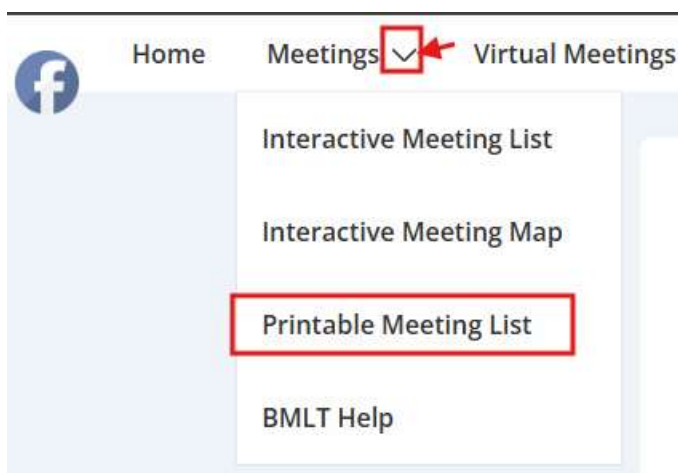

The FRC Support Merchandise sub-committee met on Sunday, 4/19/26, at 10 am via Zoom. The meeting was co-chaired by FRC Board Member Marcia C (Palm Coast) and Dennis J (Greater Orlando Area). Other attendees included Crystal & Sean M, and Reggie W (Heartland), Ramon R (River Coast), Rick H (Greater Orlando Area), Charles D (Forrest), and Cindy S (Palm Coast).

The committee approved merchandise adjustments to reduce the budget overage from \$2,070 to a minimal amount. Key decisions included eliminating certain items, reducing quantities on test products, and adjusting color options across multiple shirt categories. The pre-order shirt color was confirmed as Coco, and the committee reviewed puzzle designs for hospitality and auction. No June meeting is planned. Business will be conducted via GroupMe for volunteer scheduling and final coordination.
